

# Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

**Penny Black Products Used:** 51-169

Metropolitan, 51-232 Layered Scene, 30-358 Happy Snippets

**Additional Products:** White card stock, Black card stock, Distress inks - Ripe Persimmon, Festive Berries, Mustard Seed, Fried Brick, Cuttlebug, 3D mounting foam, Small heart punch, Liquid adhesive, Glossy Accents, Ink blending tool

## Instructions:

1. Create a square card from white card stock. Using one of the Creative Dies from the Penny Black Layered Scene die set, die cut a square window onto the front side of the card base (the good thing about this die is that it not only cuts the layered bird scene, but also a square window!)
2. Cut a small panel from white card stock that is slightly larger than the window. Using Distress inks and an ink blending tool, blend in a gradient of color to create a sunset scene (colors from top to bottom are Fired Brick, Festive Berries, Ripe Persimmon and Mustard Seed).
3. Adhere the sunset scene panel with adhesive behind the window opening.
4. Using the Penny Black Creative Die Metropolitan, die cut the buildings from white card stock. Only 4 of the buildings are needed for this project.
5. Using a liquid adhesive, adhere the buildings onto the sunset scene panel.
6. White heat emboss the Hugs sentiment from the Penny Black Happy Snippets stamp set onto black card stock. Trim around sentiment before adhering onto the card in the top right hand corner.
7. Punch a small heart from white card stock that has been colored with Festive Berries Distress ink. Adhere to one of the buildings with a liquid adhesive. Coat the heart with Glossy Accents.
