Penny Black Products Used: 30-414 Time to Celebrate, 51-338 Birthday

Additional Products: watercolor cardstock; white cardstock; black cardstock; vellum; VersaFine black ink; Hickory Smoke Distress Ink; Clarity brushes; Zig Clear Color Real Brush markers; watercolor pencils; watercolor brushes; liquid adhesive; tape adhesive

Instructions:

1. Cut a 4 ¼" x 8 ½" strip of white cardstock. Score in the middle to create a 4 ¼" square card base.
2. Stamp #30-414 Time to Celebrate image on watercolor cardstock with VersaFine black ink. Draw line under image's base in pencil.
3. Color blue background with Zig Clear Color Real Brush marker above pencil line.
4. Color hedgehog and mouse with watercolor pencils.
5. Once dry, erase pencil line. Tape vellum strip over watercolored image at bottom of blue background. Using Clarity brushes apply Hickory Smoke Distress Ink.
6. Die cut #51-338 Birthday sentiment twice from black cardstock. Adhere die cuts together with liquid adhesive for additional depth.
7. Trim colored panel to 4 ¼" square, taking into account the location of the sentiment.
8. Glue die cut sentiment to colored panel. Attach panel to card base.
