

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 51-211 Medallion Creative Die, 30-423 Banner Sentiments, 25-010 Zigs and Zags stencil

Additional Products: Watercolor card stock, White card stock, Black Card stock, Distress Oxide inks - Broken China and Cracked Pistachio, Ink Blending tool, Water, Versamark ink, White embossing powder, Anti static pillow, Cuttlebug, Liquid Adhesive, Heat gun, 3D mounting foam

Instructions:

1. Create a panel from watercolor card stock that is slightly smaller than the finished card base.
2. Using Distress Oxide ink and an ink blending tool, blend Broken China onto the top half of the panel and Cracked Pistachio onto the bottom half of the card.
3. Take the PB Zigs and Zags stencil and lightly spritz it with water (coating the whole stencil with fine water droplets).
4. Place the spritzed stencil, water side down, onto the blended card panel and set aside for about 5 minutes. This will give the water enough time to react with the inked panel (to create the oxidized effect).
5. Remove the stencil and either heat set, or set aside to air dry.
6. Die cut the PB Medallion die from white card stock.
7. Using a liquid adhesive, adhere the Medallion die cut onto the, now dried, inked panel.
8. Stamp the Especially for You sentiment from the PB Banner Sentiment stamp set in Versamark ink onto black card stock and white heat embossed it. Cut ribbon ends onto the both ends of the black panel and adhere it over the medallion die cut with 3D mounting foam.
9. Adhere the front panel onto a top folding note card.
