

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 51-362 Layered Christmas Wreath, 51-352 Birds and Banners, 30-423 Banner Sentiments

Additional Products: White card stock, Green card stock, Wood grain card stock, Copic Markers - R29, E27 and E49, Prismacolor pencil - Dark red, Memento Ink - Rich Cocoa, Versamark ink, Distress Ink - Brushed Corduroy, white embossing powder, Heat tool, Anti-static powder bag, Clear gems, Red twine, Liquid adhesive, 3D foam squares, Sponge dauber

Instructions:

1. Create a panel from white card stock and lightly ink around the edges using a sponge dauber and Memento Rich Cocoa ink.
2. Cut 4 pieces from wood-grain card stock to create panels for the door. Lightly sponge the edges of each panel using a sponge dauber and Brushed Corduroy Distress ink. Adhere to the white panel with a tape adhesive.
3. Using the PB Layered Christmas Wreath die, cut several branches from white card stock. Color the branches brown using Copic Markers E49 and E27. Color several of the berry branches red with R29.
4. Assemble the wreath, alternating the brown and red die cuts using a liquid adhesive. Adhere onto the door panel.
5. Die cut the PB Birds and Banner Creative die from white card stock, and color it using a R29 Copic marker. White heat emboss the Merry Christmas sentiment from the PB Banner Sentiments stamp set onto the banner die cut. Add subtle shading to the banner using a matching dark red Prismacolor pencil.
6. Adhere the banner over the top of the wreath using 3D mounting foam.
7. Embellish the wreath with some clear gems and a red bow made from twine. Adhere these with a liquid adhesive.
8. Mount the door panel onto a side folding green note card.
