Penny Black Products Used: Flower Medley (30-421); Sentiment Collection (30-350); Antique Frame (51-397); Flights of Fancy (51-132)

Additional Products: Dual Brush Markers (Tombow); Antique Linen Distress Ink (Ranger); Onyx Black Versafine (Tsukineko); Clear Embossing Powder (Ranger)

Instructions:

Using Antique Linen Distress Ink, stamp the rose image from Flower Medley (30-421) on white cardstock. Outline and color with watercolor markers. Use a paintbrush or watercolor pen to drag and lighten colors on the image.

Using the 3rd smallest die from Antique Frame (51-397), center the die and die cut the stamp image. Ensure that the image fills the frame. Adhere to the top center of a white cardstock card base.

Create a frame for the image by using the 3rd and 4th largest die from Antique Frame. Die-cut twice. Adhere the die cut together. Add Antique Linen to the top layer of the die cut. Adhere the frame to the card base, ensuring the frame is centered over the stamped image.

Die-cut 2 small butterflies from white cardstock using the Flights of Fancy (51-132) die set. Color with markers. Adhere the butterflies to the frame.

Stamp the sentiment from Sentiment Collection (30-350) using Onyx Black Versafine Ink and Clear Embossing Powder.
