

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 51-405 Love and Roses, 51-354 Gift Tag, 30-423 Banner Sentiments

Additional Products: Strathmore Bristol smooth white card stock, Distress Oxide Inks - Candied Apple, Worn Lipstick, Lucky Clover and Cracked Pistachio, Versamark ink, White embossing powder, Heat tool, Anti-static powder bag, Cuttlebug, Ink blending tool, Pearls, Liquid adhesive, 3D mounting foam.

Instructions:

1. On a panel of Bristol smooth white card stock that is slightly smaller than the finished card base, die cut the Love sentiment using the PB Love and Roses creative die.
2. On a smaller panel of the same card stock (that fits neatly behind the die cut panel), blend in some Candied Apple and Worn Lipstick Distress Oxide ink, creating a gradient, fading out to white. Adhere this inked panel with 3D mounting foam behind the die cut panel.
3. Die cut the flowers and leaves from the PB Gift Tag die from Bristol card stock, and ink them up with Distress Oxide Inks (Candied Apple, Worn Lipstick, Lucky Clover and Cracked Pistachio). Adhere these to the die cut panel in two clusters, opposite each other. Embellish each flower with a pearl, adhering with a liquid adhesive.
4. Selectively ink up the 'You' portion of the sentiment from the PB Banner Sentiments stamp, with Versamark ink, and white heat emboss it. Trim with scissors and adhere under the 'E' of the die cut.
5. Adhere the focal panel to the front of a square note card, made from Bristol card stock.
