

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 30-400 Hearts Aplenty, 30-286 Heartfelt, 25-010 Zigs and Zags stencil, 51-422 Stitched Square and Circles

Additional Products: X Press It smooth white card stock, VersaFine Onyx Black ink, Memento Tuxedo Black ink, Light Blue card stock, Distress Oxide Ink - Broken China, Cuttlebug, Ink blending tool, Copic Markers, Prismacolor pencils, Glossy Accents, Wink of Stella glitter brush pen, 3D mounting foam

Instructions:

1. From smooth white card stock, die cut the large square using the PB Stitched Square and circle dies.
2. Onto this square panel, stamp the cat and mouse image from the PB Hearts Aplenty stamp set using Memento Tuxedo black ink.
3. Color the image using Copic markers (Umbrella: YG03, YG17, YG67, B02, B04, B06, Y15, Y17 YR12, BV08, V04, V17, RV32, RV34, Hearts: R29, R39, Cat/Mouse: E13, E25, E31, E34, E49, E57, E59 Shading: C3, C4, C6, C7). Add shading and detail with Prismacolor pencils (PC 947 Dark Umber, PC941 Light Umber, PC943 Burnt Ochre, PC1094 Sandbar Brown, PC1084 Ginger Root, PC1083 Putty Beige).
4. Stamp the sentiment from the PB Heartfelt stamp set under the colored image with VersaFine Onyx black ink.
5. Create a square card base that is slightly bigger than the white focal panel from light blue card stock. Using the PB Zigs and Zags stencil, sponge on some Broken China Distress oxide ink. Move the stencil slightly, and sponge on ink again, to create a criss-cross pattern.
6. Mount the focal panel onto the card base with 3D mounting foam.
7. Cover the hearts with Glossy Accents and the umbrella with some clear Wink of Stella Glitter brush pen.
