

Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE

Penny Black Products Used: 40-447 Poppy Gems, 30-226 Kind Words, 51-003 Chat Bubbles

Additional Products: XPress It smooth white card stock, Strathmore Bristol smooth white card stock, Distress Oxide Ink - Wilted Violet, Peacock Feathers, Ink blending tool, Tombow Marker - Dark Purple and Dark Green, Watercolor brush pen, Paper Towel, Cuttlebug, Versamark ink, Anti-static powder bag, White embossing powder, Heat tool, 3D mounting foam, Stamping Press.

Instructions:

1. Create a panel from Strathmore Bristol smooth white card stock that is slightly smaller than the finished card base.
2. Heavily blend on some Wilted Violet Distress Oxide ink onto the panel using an ink blending tool (Peacock Feathers for the other example).
3. Once it is completely dry, stamp the PB Poppy Gems cling stamp onto the panel using Versamark ink. White heat emboss the image and set with a heat tool.
4. Using a watercolor brush pen, paint over the petals in the image, and dab away the color with some paper towel. Repeat several times until most of the color has been lifted.
5. Scribble some purple Tombow marker onto an acrylic block and with the watercolor pen, watercolor the leaves and flower centers to make them a darker shade (using a dark green Tombow marker for the other example).
6. Mount the panel onto a top folding white note card.
7. Die cut one of the speech bubbles from the PB Chat Bubble creative die set from purple (black for the other example). White heat emboss the Happy Birthday sentiment from the PB Kind Words stamp set onto the chat bubble die cut. Using scissors, trim off the little part that makes it a speech bubble.
8. 3D mount the sentiment onto the focal panel.
