

# Penny Black PROJECT GUIDE



**SIMPLICITY Sister:** Patti Kehl

**Penny Black Products Used:** 40-588 Blossom Branch, 51-128 Doodles

**Additional Products:** White cardstock, Tombow Markers, Craft Glue, Double Stick Foam Tape, Misti positioning tool

## Instructions:

Begin with a White A2 card base. Cut two 5.5 x 4.25" pieces of white card stock. Cut three .5 x 5.5" pieces of white card stock

Place one of the 5.5 x 4.25" pieces of card stock in the Misti. Line up stamp on the top of the panel in the desired location. Using Tombow colored markers color individual flowers and leaves as desired.

Lay the "Celebrate" die face down on this panel approximately 1 inch from the top. Secure in place and cut. Set the die cut aside.

Take the two remaining sections of the top panel and trim the die cut edge to a straight line.

Take two of the .5 x 5.5" pieces of cardstock and color them using a Tombow marker in the desired color. Tape one to the lower edge of the top panel section and tape the second one to the top edge of the bottom panel section.

Line up the top panel section flush with the top of the A2 card base. Position the "celebrate" die cut just under the top panel then lay the bottom panel just under the "celebrate" die cut. Trim bottom panel section to fit.

Attach the die cut directly to the card base using craft glue.

Attach the top and bottom panel sections to the card base using double stick foam tape.

Place the second 5.5 x 4.25" piece of card stock in the Misti. Line up the stamp on the bottom of the panel in the desired location. Using Tombow colored markers color individual flowers and leaves as desired. This will be attached to the inside of the card. Trim 1/8th of an inch from the bottom of this panel. Take the remaining .5 x 5.5" cardstock piece and color it using a Tombow marker in the desired color. Tape it to the lower edge of this panel. Trim 1/8th of an inch from one side of this panel and attach it directly to the inside of the card base using craft glue.
