Penny Black Products Used: 30-481
Radiant

Additional Products: Neenah Solar white card stock 110lb, Watercolor card stock, Kuretake Gansai Tambi watercolors, VersaFine Onyx black ink, Paintbrush, Heat tool, Tombow Xtreme adhesive, Stamping press

Instructions:

1. Create a panel from watercolor card stock that is slightly smaller than the finished card base.
2. Position the PB Radiant stamp in a stamping press and stamp the image using VersaFine Onyx black ink. Due to the textured nature of the watercolor card stock, you may need to stamp the image several times to get a crisp impression.
3. Using several Kuretake Gansai Tambi watercolors (pink for the flowers and several shades of green for the leaves), watercolor the floral bouquet. Heat set the image before building up additional layers of color.
4. When the floral image has been painted, create a light wash of color around the image, using a mixture of light brown and green watercolor paints.
5. Completely dry the panel (either heat set with a heat tool or leave to air dry) before stamping the Hello sentiment from the same PB Radiant stamp set in the lower right hand corner.
6. Create black splatters all over the card panel with black watercolor paint and a paintbrush (tap the paintbrush lightly to create the splatters).
7. Once dry, mount the floral panel to a top folding Neenah solar white card base with strong adhesive.
